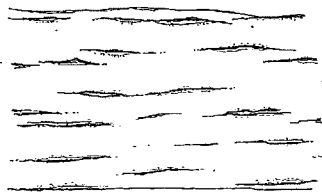


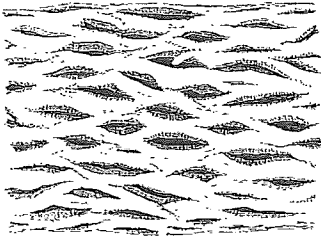

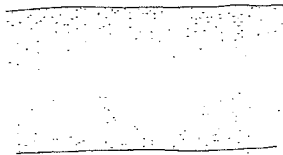
Vertical Cracks

Smooth Bark



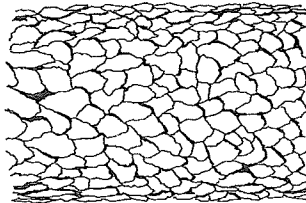
Intersecting
Ridges



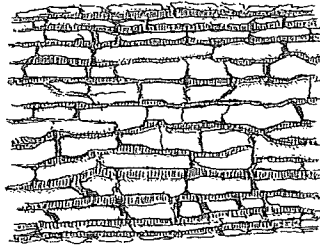
Smooth, Unbroken

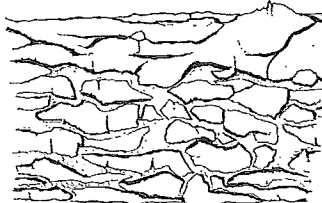

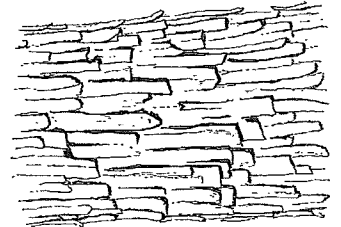
